Rules concerning borrowing

You can apply for a library card if you are a Stockholm resident. If you are an exchange student, you must be able to establish your enrolment at a college or university.

Loans are for 30 days and a book can be borrowed twice unless reserved for another reader.

You can renew loans and reserve books on loan to other borrowers on the Library website www.arkitekturmuseet.se/bibliotek. To log in you need your library card number and the PIN 1234.

Books can be returned to the Library during opening hours or, during Museum opening hours, to the Museum Receptionist (Museivärden) at the Museum entrance counter.

If books are overdue, a reminder will be sent to you. After the third reminder you will be charged SEK 600 compensation per book plus a service fee of SEK 300. The invoice will be cancelled when you return the books.

You are personally responsible for the books you borrow. You are not allowed to borrow on any one else's behalf or to lend the books to another person.

Handle the books with care. Never attempt to mend a book. If a book is damaged or lost, you will have to pay compensation as agreed with the Library.

You must notify the Library of any change in your postal or e-mail address.

If you lose your library card, the Library must be notified so that the card can be cancelled.

By signing the library card application, you declare yourself to have understood and accepted the rules concerning borrowing.

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
